After checking the area, the only thing found were tracks belonging to a bear. Officer (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) said he would put a bear trap in that area. Officer (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) also advised that due to the dry weather, it is causing the animals to come down from the mountains looking for water and food.

The persons who saw the animal were (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), both persons said that the animal they saw was standing up and had his hands in the air, both subjects were frightened, they then began telling me that the heard Bigfoot was seen at Headsprings. And that they were sure what they saw was Bigfoot. I advised them we would go up there and see what it was.
